



## A Kolkata International Children's Film Festival Publication

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In spite of having the major Kolkata Film Festival in the month of November and a few other film festivals during the year organised by film societies and other cultural centres, the city of Kolkata has not had a major film festival exclusively featuring films for children. It is against this background that the idea to hold this Kolkata International Children's Film Festival was born.

For the first edition of the festival this year, apart from some Indian and international films made in recent years, we have focussed on sourcing significant films for children made in different countries throughout the last century and the first decade of this century. Thus we have been able to cover a wide spectrum of works ranging from early classics to very recent productions. A special section *Amader Chhobi* will feature short films made by children themselves and interaction with the young makers. There is aise a special tribute to filmmaker Tapan Sinha featuring some of his children's films. A film workshop for children, a quiz on Walt Disney, a 2-day animation workshop, a colloquium on *Cinema in the Classroom* and interactive sessions between facilitators and children add new dimensions to the festival. A special attraction throughout the festival will be a vintage peep-show box and bioscope on the Rabindra Sadan-Nandan lawn.

With the Christmas nip in the air and a varied fare of over 150 feature films, shorts and documentaries from over 15 countries spread over 10 venues in different parts of the city, the festival will surely provide a lot of choice for entertainment and interaction for children and their accompanying teachers, parents, friends and relatives during the festival week.

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





While his class-mates bring their very own Tiffin-boxes, Stanley does not do so on the pretext that his mother is away, and shares food vith Aman Mehra and others much to the chagrin of the Hindi Teacher, Babubhai Verma, who not only cajoles fellow-teachers, but virtually forces children, to share their food with him. With extra classes being imposed on both students and teachers, and the recess-breaks being doubled, parents are also forced to pack more food in lunch-boxes. When students evade Babubhai and continue sharing food with Stanley, he calls the latter aside and warns him that he cannot attend school until and unless he brings his own food. Watch what impact this has on Stanley, teachers, and his class-mates.

Fairytales and music form an integral part of Lotte Reiniger's (1899-1981) artistic oeuvre and were both driving forces behind her work. For THE ADVENTURES OF PRINCE ACHMED (IN 1945) she drew on oriental motifs. She lived in London after the Second World War and set to work on European fairytales: the Brothers Grimm from Germany, Perrault from France, and Danish fairytale poet Andersen. KALIF STORCH illustrates that The Arabian Nights also remained a source of inspiration. She roamed through these different cultures, using them as stimuli to spur her on to new ideas. Her creative skills and an ever-present subtle humour save her fairytale subjects from lapsing into insipid sentimentality. Her characters are light and vivacious beings who move with balanced grace and beauty, but nevertheless remain firmly anchored in reality. The accompanying DVD features 18 of Lotte Reiniger's preserved works, some in several different versions and all restored to the highest possible technical quality.

Award-winning Australian filmmaker Mike Dillon has captured the beauty, physical stress and emotion that Tim Macartney-Snape and his wife, Dr. Ann Ward, experienced during the first complete ascent of Mt Everest. Begining with Tim's training runs through the shimmering heat of Westerr Australia's arid interior, the film captures him setting ogg from the tropical waters of the Bay of Bengal and walking through the clamour of India into the fresh Himalayar foothills. At Everest's base camp the seriousness of his goa to climb the mountain solo and without supplementary oxygen confronts Tim and Ann.
